

Your Company Member Profile on www.bvl.de/en

Use your BVL Corporate Membership to present your company in BVL's Members Directory. You can write a short description about your company, integrate a link to your company's website, and upload your company logo.

To add your company's profile, just follow the next four steps:

- a) Use your member login details to access the site
- b) Click on Company Member Profiles
- c) Enter your company's name, a profile description, and your website into the entry boxes, and upload your company's logo
- d) Wait for the BVL to review and activate your Company Member Profile

Manual: Entering your Company Member Profile

- 1) Open www.bvl.de/en and use your access data to log in


- 2) Using the sidebar on the left-hand-side scroll the following paths Association>Members Overview>Corporate Members in Portrait. Click on „Add profile“.

- 2b) Then click "Create entry"

- 3) You will then arrive at the „Create entry“-screen. Add the name of your company and a short description of your company’s profile as well as your website URL. Upload your company logo. Once you have entered all of the information, click on “Save”.
