New International Supply Chain Conference Programme Update Available



The updated programme for the upcoming International Supply Chain Conference 2020 is now online! The conference takes place from 21st - 23rd October under the theme Sustainability in Action - Winning the Next Decade. This year's conference will be hosted as a hybrid event - an on-site conference with quidelines and limited attendance, and at the same time, with online streaming services offered to those not attending in person. On top of that, you can get a taste of some of the content before the conference begins, free of charge and without having to travel to Berlin: five Pre-Events will be available in advance in the form of free webinars. The topic on 30th September is Sustainability in Transport Logistics, while Infrastructure for a Sustainable Business Location is on the agenda on 1st October. The next day, young logistics talents will be presenting their award-winning dissertations at the Thesis Conference. On 6th October it's all about the Circular Economy which will be completely in English and features the Netherlands BVL Representative, Corine van der Sloot. And, last but not least, those who are interested can follow the Grand Final -2020 Science Award for SCM on 8th October. The award itself will be presented on the first evening of the conference in Berlin.


