



Logistics Indicator in Q4 2021 - Dampened euphoria at year-end

A fourth wave of the corona pandemic is currently rolling through economy and society, and the fact that the vaccination camp progress for several months means that Germany is not as well prepared to face the challenge as it could have been. The situ aggravated further by escalating supply bottlenecks and the repeated interruptions to production output. Short-time work is o generally on the increase. All of these factors negatively impact expectations and are mirrored in the Logistics Indicator for Q^2 approach the end of this second crisis year. The year 2021 was like 2020 overshadowed by the Corona pandemic, but logistics professionals were once again showing that they can accept and master the challenges BVL's motto for the year was appropriately: Chancen nutzen Adapt to Lead." BVL members showed their solidarity and confirmed an increase in membership dues and a special levy to compensate for pandemic-related losses. BVL employees additionally went on short-time work for several months. Thanks to the joint commitment, it was a good year for BVL in spite of the continuing tense situation due to the adverse circumstances. Despite the different regulations in the various countries, BVL's international chapters also put on a double-digit number of events and the chapter chairpersons met to exchange experiences in virtual meet-ups. The 10th International Scientific Symposium on Logistics (ISSL), titled "Logistics for a Sustainable Future - Contributions from Science", took place as an online event. 176 participants from all over the world came together in virtual space, making the symposium, which as always was held in English, more international than ever before. The International Supply Chain Conference was held hybrid with a large on-site event in Berlin, to which BVL could welcome 1,301 participants.
