The English-language symposium was thus more international than ever before. It was prepared by the Scientific Advisory Board of BVL, chaired by **Prof. Kai Furmans** (in the photo below), and organized by the Logistics Department of TU Dresden, headed by **Prof. Thorsten Schmidt** (above). Co-organizer was Fraunhofer IML under the leadership of **Prof. Michael ten Hompel**. The program included three keynote lectures and six tracks. The contents are documented in the conference volume, which is now available for download on the Internet. The next ISSL will take place on June 21 and 22, 2022.

#### Out of Lockdown with Momentum

While the February survey of the ifo Institute described the Logistics Indicator as "resilient", this rating can now be upgraded to "dynamic". A favourable business situation and even better business expectations have pushed the overall indicator back up to the "normal level" - with the result that it is now above the pre-crisis score. The business climate is far brighter, and the primary indicator showed a strong increase and stood at 102.5 points in May.
