Up to 50 young scientists can be awarded with BVL's annual Thesis Award. BVL created this award for outstanding bachelor and master theses in 2010. Professors in supply chain management and logistics-related institutes at universities, universities of applied science and universities of cooperative education have the possibility of recognizing excellent theses and therefore outstanding future logisticians. Potential restriction notes of involved parties do not cause any problem, only the title of the theses is being published.

Entries are possible through the supervising university lecturer only. The variety of topics in supply chain management and logistics are reflected in the high number of winners and topics, too.

The Thesis Award 2018 includes following:

- A certificate.
- A complimentary ticket for our 35th International Supply Chain Conference held in Berlin from October 17-19, 2018.
- Important remark for awardees from abroad: travel expenses to Berlin are not included.

Terms of Participation:

- **Outstanding** thesis (bachelor thesis and master thesis),
- The supervising university lecturer is member of BVL or BVL Austria
- The thesis is supposed to be **application-oriented**, and **highly relevant** for logistics and supply chain management.
- The thesis was completed and evaluated between July 1, 2017 and June 30, 2018.
- Per university lecturer and chair we accept one submission per year only and up to five per site.
- In total per year up to 50 awardees are possible. If we receive a higher number of submissions, the date of submission is deciding.
- All decisions are final.

What do you have to do in order to nominate a young scientist for BVL's Thesis Awards 2018?

- Entries are possible through the supervising university lecturer only.
- Only within this timeframe: June 1-30, 2018 by using this **online-form**.
- In this form we need the first and the last name of your young scientist and the title of the work. Furthermore please explain to us, why she/he should be awarded.
- Afterwards both of you will obtain a mail explaining further steps.
- We are very much looking forward meeting your awardee.
